FOR GEELONG

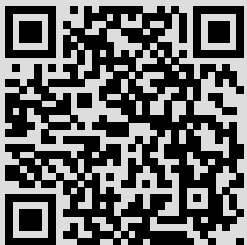
Two large fossil fuel companies (Viva & Vopak) want to build gas import terminals in our bay. This would take our community in the wrong direction. Gas is a fossil fuel like coal, and a major cause of the climate crisis.

We're calling on the Victorian government to reject these gas terminals from Viva and Vopak, and support Geelong with investment in renewable energy jobs instead.

Floating gas terminals are a threat to life in our bay. The Victorian government has already rejected a gas terminal in Westernport Bay because of "unacceptable" risks to the marine environment.

The gas terminal and LNG tanker ships would need exclusion zones, permanently changing access to Corio Bay for boating, fishing and the residents of North Shore.

We already have enough gas. Australia is the world's biggest gas exporter so we don't need to import it. The latest official gas forecast shows we have enough supply until 2026. Government programs to reduce gas will mean these projects aren't needed beyond 2026.
